- General Resolutions Committee.

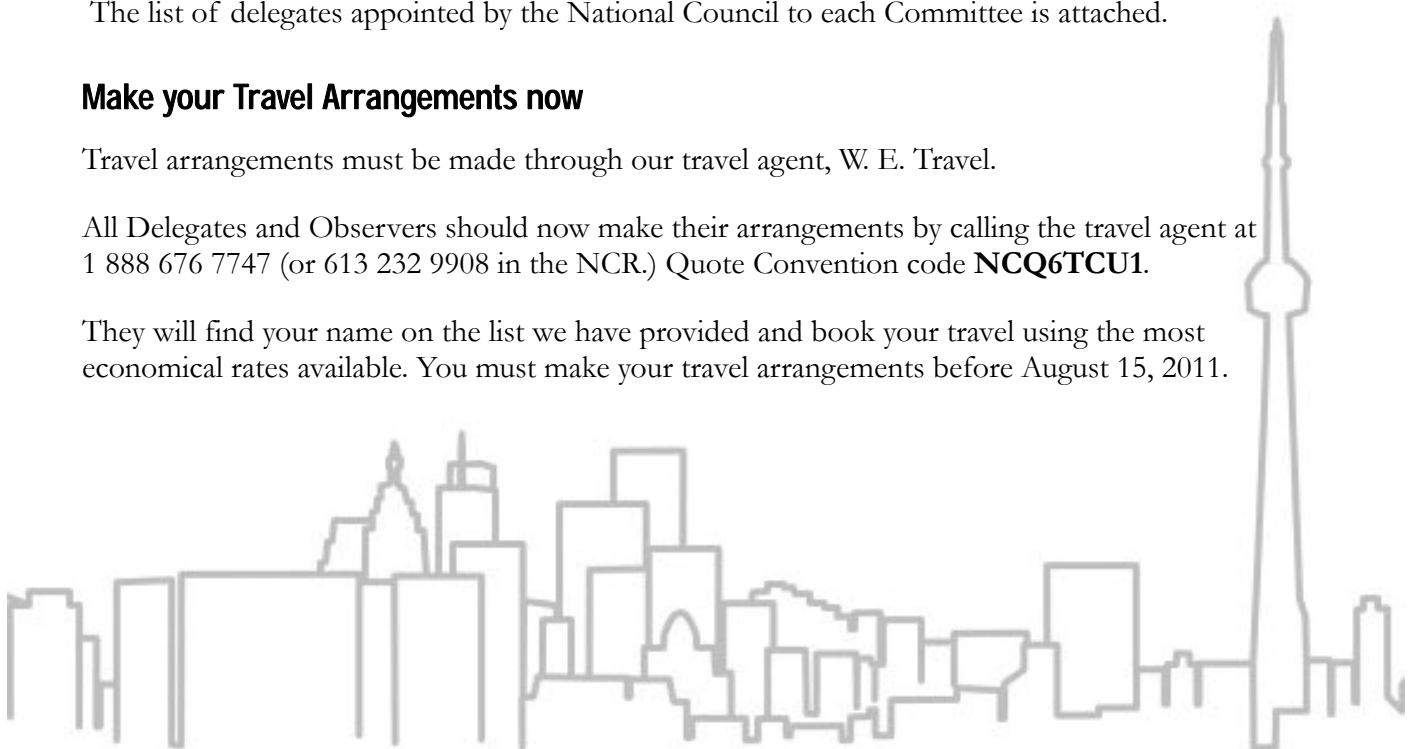
The list of delegates appointed by the National Council to each Committee is attached.

Make your Travel Arrangements now

Travel arrangements must be made through our travel agent, W. E. Travel.

All Delegates and Observers should now make their arrangements by calling the travel agent at 1 888 676 7747 (or 613 232 9908 in the NCR.) Quote Convention code **NCQ6TCU1**.

They will find your name on the list we have provided and book your travel using the most economical rates available. You must make your travel arrangements before August 15, 2011.



Things to remember about travel arrangements:

- If you live in Ontario, the National Capital Region, or Montreal you will travel to the convention by bus, train or personal car, unless advised otherwise by the GSU National Officer or W.E. Travel.
- If you are a **member of the National Council**, your first meeting will be Friday, October 21, so you should arrive the evening of Thursday, October 20.
- If you are **appointed to a Convention Resolutions Committee**, your first meeting will be Saturday, October 22, so you should arrive the evening of Friday, October 21.
- If you are **not on a Convention Resolutions Committee**, you are invited to arrive in time for the reception on the evening of Monday, October 24.
- The convention will probably adjourn by 5:00 pm on Thursday, October 27 but it could be later. Do not choose a flight that leaves Toronto earlier than 8:00 pm. Most delegates outside of the Toronto area will probably travel home on the Friday morning.
- The newly elected National Council will hold a brief meeting on the morning of Friday, October 28.
- Travel arrangements for Observers or guests or for delegate stops en-route should also be made through our travel agent. However, you will be required to charge these costs to your personal credit card when you book them.
